Mike distributed copies of our 2006 Agriculture License to people who have foster dogs.


ADOPTION COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

We have received some calls on the Adoption Line from people who are an hour or more outside of St. Louis. However, we are the closest Golden rescue group to the people who have called. If no one is willing to do the home visit, it *is* possible to adopt to these people. Ask them to get a letter of recommendation from their vet and from someone who knows them well, such as a neighbor or co-worker. They should also submit photos which show their yard, including the fence; and photos of the rooms

where the dog will be spending its time. A home visit is always preferred, but we can make an exception when distance is a problem.
